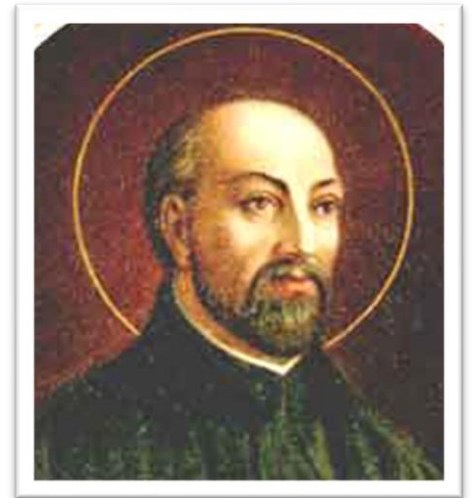


## **Saint Jean de Brebeuf**

## **Miracle of St Jean de Brebeuf**

Five years later, in 1925, she was gravely afflicted with fibrocaceous tubercular peritonitis. Attending physicians finally declared that further treatment was useless. The afflicted nun, and her community, sought the miraculous intercession of the North American martyrs. On June 9, 1925, she was instantly and permanently cured.
